**Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – April 22, 2024**

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America. Construction is now underway on Sandwich Street with road reconstruction and watermain installation activities occurring in various locations. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team will provide weekly email updates.

A summary of the planned construction activities for the week of April 22, 2024 is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains. Activities may shift as needed.

**Road Reconstruction Work - McKee Road to Ojibway Parkway Intersection:**

Activities anticipated the week of April 22, 2024:

- Flushing and inspection of storm sewer pipe
- Placement and grading of granular road base
- Installation of road subdrains.

**New Work to Start April 29, 2024: Road Reconstruction Work – Ojibway Parkway Intersection to Essex Terminal Railway Tracks**

The next segment of work along Sandwich Street is anticipated to begin April 29, 2024, between the Ojibway Parkway intersection (near the Lou Romano Treatment Plant) and Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) tracks. This work will include full road reconstruction including curbs, sidewalks and driveways and installation of a multi-use trail. Two-way traffic will be maintained throughout, with construction occurring between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm.

Work next week will begin with sign placement, preparation for lanes closures, island removal and temporary asphalt paving. Following these preparations road, driveway and sidewalk removal will begin in the designated work area (southbound lanes).

**Sandwich Street Watermain Work:**

Bridging North America is undertaking watermain installation on Sandwich Street between Chappell Avenue and Chewett Street in advance of road reconstruction. Construction activities will take place in segments as follows:

- Chappell Avenue to Prince Road (currently underway)
- Prince Road to South Street
- South Street to Brock Street (currently underway)
- Brock Street to Chewett Street



This work requires rolling lane closures, temporary parking restrictions and some access restrictions to side streets throughout this stretch of Sandwich Street. Through the use of flaggers, sections of Sandwich Street will be reduced to one lane of two-way traffic during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Two lanes will reopen to traffic during overnight hours. During construction, access to adjacent residences, businesses and pedestrian walkways will be maintained.

#### **Activities anticipated the week of April 22:**

- Saw cutting occurring in all phases identified above
- Watermain installation is occurring between Chappell Ave to Prince Road and will shift to the segment between Prince Rd and South Street once complete. Watermain installation is also underway between South St to Brock St.
- Directional drilling on Hill Street and Watkins Street.

As sections of work are completed, the roadway will reopen to two lanes of traffic.

#### **Monthly Drop-In Meetings**
