Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – August 19, 2024

Funded through the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street is being reconstructed by Bridging North America. Construction is well underway on Sandwich Street with road reconstruction activities occurring in various locations. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team is providing weekly email updates.

A summary of the construction activities for the week of August 19, 2024, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains. Activities may shift as needed.

Road Reconstruction Work: McKee Road to Ojibway Parkway Intersection – NOW OPEN:

Anticipated Activities:

- Work continues on the sanitary sewer pipe (ongoing)
- Asphalt paving of the multi-use trail (ongoing)
- Top soil and seeding to follow the paving work.

The intersection of Sandwich and Ojibway is now open to traffic.

Road Reconstruction Work: Ojibway Parkway Intersection to Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) Tracks

Anticipated Activities:

- Saw cutting and road/driveway removals on northbound lanes
- Catch basin and culvert installation.

Two-way traffic and access to businesses will continue to be maintained throughout this work.

Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) work is scheduled for August 26 and 27 and will require a full closure of Sandwich Street. During this closure, ETR tracks will be replaced along with road paving work. The City of Windsor is coordinating this work with ETR. Questions should be directed to 311.

Sandwich Street Watermain Work:

Watermain installation and all service tie-ins are complete. Restoration efforts along side streets and hydrant removals continue to be ongoing.

Road Reconstruction

Bridging North America began work to reconstruct Sandwich Street from Chappell Avenue to the roundabout on June 12, 2024. This work will take place for approximately six months and includes asphalt paving and sidewalks, the addition of new bicycle lanes and enhanced streetscaping within the Sandwich BIA district from Brock Street through Detroit Street.



Traffic will be detoured around the active work zones as follows:

- All truck traffic will use Russell Street for both directions of travel
- All non-truck traffic will use Peter Street for northbound travel and Russell Street for southbound travel.

Anticipated Activities:

Chappell to Watkins Street

- Base layer of asphalt will be placed this week
- Topsoil and sod placement is anticipated for next week.

Watkins to Chippawa Street

- Curb placement along east side will be completed this week
- Base layer of asphalt will be placed this week
- Boulevard work from South Street to Chippawa Street to follow
- Topsoil and sod placement will be completed after sidewalk/curb work is complete.

Chippawa to Brock Street

- Road/sidewalk removals (ongoing)
- Conduit is being installed for the traffic signals at Brock
- Curb placement.

Brock to Mill Street

- Tree removal at identified locations
- Prep work for curb installation
- Removals at Mill Street intersection.

Mill to North Limits

- Road removals/cuts began at Mill intersection and will continue north.

Note: Canada post has adjusted mail delivery in some locations along Sandwich Street. Canada Post will be notifying affected property owners directly and sharing updated information as it becomes available. Please direct any questions related to mail delivery to 519-972-2501 ext. 2105.
