Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – July 15, 2024

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America. Construction is now underway on Sandwich Street with road reconstruction and watermain installation activities occurring in various locations. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team will provide weekly email updates.

A summary of the construction activities for the week of July 15, 2024, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains. Activities may shift as needed.

Road Reconstruction Work - McKee Road to Ojibway Parkway Intersection:

Anticipated Activities:

- Work is underway on the sanitary sewer pipe (continuation)
- Asphalt paving of the multi-use trail (continuation).

The intersection of Sandwich and Ojibway will remain closed until the southbound lanes between Ojibway Parkway to Essex Terminal Railway Tracks are complete. Access to businesses will be maintained through the detour route:

Road Reconstruction Work – Ojibway Parkway Intersection to Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) Tracks

Anticipated Activities:

- Placement and curing of concrete in southbound lanes, including curbs and islands (finishing this week)
- Pump station installation and connections (finishing this week)
- Catch basin installation (finishing this week)
- Work on pump station underground duct banks (anticipated for next week)
- Pour and cure driveways in southbound lanes (anticipated for next week).

Sandwich Street Watermain Work:

Bridging North America (BNA) is undertaking watermain installation on behalf of Enwin Utilities on Sandwich Street between Chappell Avenue and Chewett Street in advance of road reconstruction. Construction activities are taking place in the following segments:

- Chappell Avenue to Prince Road
- Prince Road to South Street
- South Street to Brock Street
- Brock Street to Chewett Street



Anticipated Activities:

- Service connections to residents and businesses underway between Brock and Detroit Street. ENWIN Utilities will coordinate these connections directly with affected properties (continuation)
- Removal of old hydrants.

Road Reconstruction:

Bridging North America began work to reconstruct Sandwich Street from Chappell Avenue to the roundabout on June 12, 2024. This work will take place for approximately six months and includes asphalt paving and sidewalks, the addition of new bicycle lanes and enhanced streetscaping within the Sandwich BIA district from Brock Street through Detroit Street.

Construction crews will transition from the current watermain work, right into the Phase 3 Reconstruction work with closures occurring in the segments referenced above. Work has started between Chappell Avenue and Brock Street.

Anticipated Activities:

- Excavation of boulevards, sidewalks, driveways (Chappell to Watkins)
- Sidewalk and driveway concrete pours (continuation)
- Road cutting (Watkins to Brock)
- Removal of trees in identified locations (anticipated to begin next week).

Traffic will be detoured around the active work zone as follows:

- All truck traffic will use Russell Street for both directions of travel
- All non-truck traffic will use Peter Street for northbound travel and Russell Street for southbound travel.

Monthly Sandwich Drop-in Meeting

To help keep the community informed about Sandwich Street reconstruction, the project team is holding their monthly drop-in meeting on Thursday, July 25, 2024, between 5pm-7pm. Drop in to the Community Office at 3201 Sandwich Street in Windsor to meet project representatives, get the latest Sandwich Street reconstruction updates and share your feedback. Meetings will be open-house format and held on the fourth Thursday of every month.
