**Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – May 21, 2024**

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America. Construction is now underway on Sandwich Street with road reconstruction and watermain installation activities occurring in various locations. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team will provide weekly email updates.

A summary of the construction activities for the week of May 21, 2024, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains. Activities may shift as needed.

**Road Reconstruction Work - McKee Road to Ojibway Parkway Intersection:**

Anticipated Activities:

- Placement and curing of concrete curbs
- Grading and granular placement for driveways and multi-use path.

The intersection of Sandwich and Ojibway will be closed beginning later this week and will remain closed until the southbound lanes between Ojibway Parkway to Essex Terminal Railway Tracks are complete. **Road Reconstruction Work – Ojibway Parkway Intersection to Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) Tracks**

Anticipated Activities:

- Grading of the road base and placement of the open-graded drainage layer in the southbound lanes in preparation for concrete paving.

**Sandwich Street Watermain Work:**

Bridging North America (BNA) is undertaking watermain installation on Sandwich Street between Chappell Avenue and Chewett Street in advance of road reconstruction. Construction activities are taking place in the following segments:

- Chappell Avenue to Prince Road
- Prince Road to South Street
- South Street to Brock Street
- Brock Street to Chewett Street (currently underway)



#### Anticipated Activities:

- Pressure testing and flushing in select segments with service connections to residents and businesses to follow. ENWIN Utilities will coordinate these connections directly with affected properties.
- Watermain installation between Brock St and Chewett Street.

#### Traffic Update:

A change in the approach to traffic management during watermain construction currently underway along Sandwich Street is necessary following ongoing safety inspections. Anticipated to start May 30, 2024, and lasting approximately 2 months, Bridging North America will put rolling full closures of Sandwich Street in place, within active construction zones to ensure the safety of the construction crews currently undertaking the work.

Traffic will be detoured around the active work zone as follows:

- All truck traffic will use Russell Street for both directions of travel
- All non-truck traffic will use Peter Street for northbound travel and Russell Street for southbound travel.

#### Monthly Drop-In Meeting:

To help keep the community informed about Sandwich Street construction, the project team is launching a monthly drop-in meeting. Join us for the second Sandwich Neighbour Meeting. Drop in to meet project representatives, get the latest Sandwich Street construction updates and share your feedback. Meetings are open-house format and held on the fourth Thursday of the month.
