Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – November 6, 2023

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America. Sandwich Street reconstruction work is now underway with the first segment of work ongoing between the Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) crossing and Chappell Avenue. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team will provide weekly email updates.

A summary of the planned construction activities for the week of November 6, 2023, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains, so some activities may shift as needed:

Activities completed last week:

- Placement and grading of granular base and drainage layer
- Inspection of storm sewer installations
- Placement of open graded drainage layer
- Preparation and set up for paving work.

Activities anticipated the week of November 6:

- Placement and curing of concrete curbs
- Placement and curing of concrete pavement on infill lanes and intersection.
