Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – October 9, 2023

As part of the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street will be reconstructed by Bridging North America. Sandwich Street reconstruction work is now underway with the first segment of work ongoing between the Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) crossing and Chappell Avenue. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team will provide weekly email updates.

A summary of the planned construction activities for the week of October 9, 2023, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains, so some activities may shift as needed:

Activities completed last week:

- Placement and curing of concrete curbs
- Excavation and placement of granular for driveways

Activities anticipated the week of October 9:

- Placement and curing of concrete driveways
- Excavation, grading and placement of granular for sidewalk work
- Placement and curing of concrete sidewalk.

It is anticipated that the current traffic configuration will switch to construct the opposite side of Sandwich Street between ETR and Chappell Ave late next week (week of October 16), with northbound traffic continuing to be maintained. We will provide additional information in next week's update.
