Subject: Weekly Sandwich Street Activities Update – December 2, 2024

Funded through the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, just over three kilometres of Sandwich Street is being reconstructed by Bridging North America. Construction is well underway on Sandwich Street with road reconstruction activities occurring in various locations. To help keep the community informed on activities planned for Sandwich Street, the project team is providing weekly email updates.

A summary of the construction activities for the week of December 2, 2024, is below. Please keep in mind that construction is subject to weather and supply chains. Activities may shift as needed.

Road Reconstruction

Bridging North America began work to reconstruct Sandwich Street from Chappell Avenue to the roundabout on June 12, 2024. This work will take place for approximately six months and includes asphalt paving and sidewalks, the addition of new bicycle lanes and enhanced streetscaping within the Sandwich BIA district from Brock Street through Detroit Street.

Traffic will continue to be detoured around the active work zones as follows:

- All truck traffic will use Russell Street for both directions of travel
- All non-truck traffic will use Peter Street for northbound travel and Russell Street for southbound travel.

Anticipated Activities:

Chippawa Street to Brock Street

- The project team is accommodating the City's concrete crosswalk installation at the Brock Street intersection. See attached City of Windsor traffic closure information related to this work. It is anticipated that the road will be closed from December 2 - December 10, 2024 (weather permitting). For more information about this work call 311.

Brock Street to Mill Street

- Installation of street lights and traffic signals
- Form/pour remaining sidewalks
- Paver and planter installation
- Topsoil/mulch placement



Mill Street to Chewett Street

- Installation of street lights and traffic signals
- Planter and paver installation
- Topsoil/mulch placement.

Our next quarterly Public Information Meeting will be held on December 4, 2024, in Windsor at Mackenzie Hall from 3:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The meeting will provide the latest updates on Canadian and US construction activities, Sandwich Street Reconstruction and the implementation of the Gordie Howe International Bridge Community Benefits Plan. Presentations will begin at 3:30 p.m. and 5:15 p.m. followed by a question-and-answer session.
