

Funded by the Gordie Howe International Bridge project, three kilometres of Sandwich Street was reconstructed from the Canadian Port of Entry at McKee Avenue to the Rosedale Avenue roundabout. Sandwich Street reconstruction work began in summer 2023 and was completed in December 2024. Streetscaping and landscaping work resumed this spring and is nearing completion.



Reconstruction work included:

- new streets and sidewalks
- cycling infrastructure
- new stormwater sewer

In addition to the reconstruction work, the Sandwich Business Improvement Area (BIA) was enhanced through an additional \$1 million Community Benefits Plan investment. These enhancements included the addition of landscaping, hardscaping and gathering spaces creating a vibrant area for residents and visitors.

The City of Windsor also invested in the area with additional enhancements including aesthetic crosswalk improvements.
