We've posted a new flyover and new **photo gallery** of the bridge site on our website. This most recent look captures the line painting on the bridge deck and the installation of the fencing along the bridge edge. Have you witnessed the testing of the aesthetic lighting?

There are 5,000 white energy-efficient, LED lights along the linear the edge the bridge deck span, at the piers along the back span, at the stay cables, and at the towers.

Broadway Street Multi-Use Path and Malden Park Trailhead Now Open

The Broadway Street multi-use path is complete and the Malden Park Trailhead and bike racks have been installed. The Gordie Howe International Bridge project team and the City of Windsor unveiled the path and trailhead in late September.

This new active transportation feature will connect into the Canadian Port of Entry once the bridge is open. In addition to the path, the new trailhead at Malden Park provides a safe place for multi-use path users meet and park. Funding for the Broadway Street multi-use path connection and Malden Park Trailhead was provided by the Community Benefits Plan.
